EDITORIAL

The present long-awaited issue has been delayed because of financial considerations, and we apologise sincerely to subscribers. The publication of volume 18 should follow within a year to bring us more or less up to date with the programme of lectures; and the Council's declared policy is to make every effort to ensure regular publication of the Proceedings which are a very important part of the activities of the Society.

The next issue should contain reviews of books for which there is no space in the current volume. Perhaps special mention should be made however of the British Library's exhibition to mark the 2000th anniversary of Virgil's death. The exhibition, originally scheduled from 17 September 1982 to the 27 February 1983, has at the time of writing been retained for a further period. The British Library also published 'Virgil: His Poetry through the Ages' by R.D. Williams and T.S. Pattie to coincide with the opening of the exhibition.
